Members Attain National Certification

The Waymart Volunteer Fire Company hosted the Firefighter I Recruit Class this past summer and fall. A person certified at the Firefighter I level will have demonstrated competency in the necessary knowledge and skills while working under direct supervision to function safely and effectively as a member of a firefighting team. Our members completed over 200 hours of training which included lectures and practical skills.

To obtain national certification, each member must pass written and practical exams. The member must also pass Hazmat Operations Class and a live structural burn. To date, 8 of our members have passed all of these requirements and 4 have continued on with 25 hours of additional training and have passed their Firefighter II Certification. Additional members are in the process of completing their training to become certified.

One other benefit to this training is that each certification improves the chances of attaining grants. For the PA State grants, it also provides an increase in the dollar value allocated to the Company.

Federal Grant Funds

In February the Fire Company was awarded an Assistance to Firefighters Grant from FEMA for the replacement of 5" LDH (large diameter hose). This grant is beneficial to the community because this hose is used to transport large volumes of water long distances.

The hose is used both in the Boro and in the rural areas. This is replacing hose that is in some cases over 25 years old.

Also included in the grant is hose testing equipment and a hose washer. These items will assist in maintaining the hose and certifying that it is safe to use.
